➤ Best practices in EHR integration/interstate data sharing queries

- Scenario for credential exchange (Jean Hall, Clay Rogers)

Jean Hall (KY) provided the subcommittee with the language that she and Clay Rogers (Appriss) drafted:

Ability to utilize a user's DEA controlled substance registration, NPI, or state license number identifier from a request sent by a health system or pharmacy system to verify that user has an active account with the home state's PDMP before releasing the PDMP report. If the user's identifier is not associated with an active account at the home state PDMP, then the message is returned denying access to the PDMP report.

Subcommittee decided that the above text would be applicable to all the scenarios listed and should be listed at the start of the best practices document. Recommendation to include user role and permissions (i.e., role permission, authority by state) at the start of this section. Rodd Kelly (MA) and Nilu Kundagrami (Scriptulate) will draft some language for this part of the document and send to TTAC to send to the subcommittee for review and edit.
