



- Interactive data tool to create customized reports
- Reports available for downloads as Excel or PDF files.

 - Greater than 90MME on average per day
 - Buprenorphine dispensing
- **Statewide analysis:**
 - Total Opioid prescriptions and patients
 - Total prescriptions for Opioid, Buprenorphine, Stimulants and Other Controlled Substances



Multiple Provider Episodes - 2018


Patients who have received 5 or more prescriptions from 5 or more pharmacies in a 6 months period (per 100,000 population).

This data is based on patient's address on file. There are some patients who have incorrect addresses (zip codes) linked to their profile. We are working on cleaning the data which may result in altering county totals in future.

The data is limited to the prescriptions dispensed at commercial pharmacies in the State of Illinois. The accuracy of this data is based on what's reported to the ILPMP.

The accuracy of indicators based on PDMP data is limited by the completeness and quality of the data. Total figures and calculations on patient and provider level are achieved by joining multiple datasets together based on unique identifiers. These procedures vary in completeness and accuracy.



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
Age group and Gender Distributions


Age group and Gender Distributions


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Statewide Trends for Total Prescriptions


