Must have a current DEA Registration number and state license number.

Criteria for Prescriber delegates to get account:

Must have either a Virginia license or have signed a patient confidentiality agreement. Both licensed and unlicensed delegates must be authorized by their prescriber or pharmacist supervisor.

Criteria for Dispenser delegates to get account:

Must have either a Virginia license or have signed a patient confidentiality agreement. Both licensed and unlicensed delegates must be authorized by their prescriber or pharmacist supervisor.

Criteria for PAs to get account:

Must have a current license with authorization to prescribe.

Criteria for Nurse Practitioners to get account:

Must have a current license with authorization to prescribe.

Criteria for other users to get account:

Requirements for Patients to get PDMP Report:

Over the age of eighteen. Must submit a notarized recipient request form with a copy of a picture ID.

Requirements for others to get PDMP Report:

Criteria for Online Non-healthcare accounts:

Licensing/regulatory Board investigators, Law Enforcement investigators (federal, state, and local), Medical Examiners/coroners, Pardons or Parole officers, Medicaid HMO specific personnel to determine eligibility for a patient management program
