What is a Health Information Network (HIN)?



- · Electronically exchanges patients' medical information
- Improves the speed, quality, safety, and cost of patient care
- Informs clinical decisions when seconds & minutes matter




Incubated by the federal government, the eHealth Exchange is a non-profit with a mission to mature nationwide data sharing for the public good.


Challenges

- 1. Clinicians need PDMP data to make **safer, more informed decisions**
- 2. Clinicians need medication lists **combined** with other data in their EHR:
 - Toxicology results
 - Risk assessments
 - Social determinants
- 3. Clinicians need PDMP data via **natural workflows** with no new fees
 - EHR PDMP modules
 - Web Portals
- 4. Clinicians need PDMP data **before** prescription writing begins
- 5. Interstate exchange



Distribute state PDMP data as appropriate to inform clinicians of:


- ✓ Controlled substance history






Objective: Support PDMP Exchange During Disaster Response




RxCheck Hub – Growing Footprint

PDMP EHR Data Integration – Conceptual Architecture

- Inform trusted clinicians of other states' PDMP data as appropriate
- Leverage natural EHR workflows vs web portals
- Inform clinicians during the medication reconciliation process, <u>before</u> prescription writing begins
