Roll Call

Quorum established

Approval of Minutes from 4-20-2020

Motion to approve the minutes was made by Jean Hall (KY); seconded by Jennifer Marlowe (ME). Unanimously approved.

ONC Report on Reducing Regulatory and Administrative Burden Relating to the Use of Health IT and EHRs (Dr. Andy Gettinger)

Dr. Any Gettinger (ONC) provided a brief overview of the ONC report; specifically, on the burdens encountered with the transition of health records into the digital environment and identify ways to ease those burdens. The burdens were organized into categories: documentation and billing with EHRs, quality reporting, requirements with EHR and technology, and feedback concerning prescriber challenges with PDMPs and EPCS. Their task now is to further understand the burdens and implement recommendations to remedy.

Update from Patient Matching Working Group Kevin Borcher (NE) mentioned that the group is reviewing the patient segment of the ASAP

format and identifying metrics around data quality, how to calculate those metrics, how to measure data quality, and methods to improve metrics.

Update from PMIX Schema Working Groups

Jean Hall (KY) mentioned that the group has almost completed the schemas: 1) metadata and new data elements and 2) request and response schemas. When completed by the workgroup, they will be submitted to the Executive Committee to approve. If approved, they will be sent to the PDMP Administrators for comment, comments will be addressed, and a final vote on the schema changes will be made.

PMIX Website and Logo

TTAC reviewed efforts from the website workgroup and displayed suggested language for the Operations Subcommittee webpage as well as new PMIX logo. TTAC mentioned that a mock-up of the webpages should be available for review before the end of June.
