Oregon Revised Statute 431.966(4): Information in the prescription monitoring program that identifies an individual patient must be removed no later than three years from the date the information is entered into the program. Law requires only purging patient information older than 3 years, but we purge all data within the system older than 3 years. This happens on a rolling monthly basis.

Prescribes with Oregon licensure and active DEA. Dispensers - Exemptions include: state and federal correctional facility pharmacies, inpatient pharmacies (hospital, in-patient care facilities), Long Term Care pharmacies, student health center pharmacies, pharmacies dispensing fewer than 16 prescriptions annually (with waiver), pharmacies not licensed to dispense CS.

Enrollment Effective Date(s): March 27, 2018 (statute; practitioners must register by July 1, 2018); April 5, 2018 (regulation)

Pharmacists with authority to prescribe pseudoephedrine products must query the PDMP prior to issuing such a prescription.
